IMPORTANT EVENT INFORMATION !! BE SURE TO READ THIS!!

Location: Mazda Laguna Seca Raceway, Hwy 68, Monterey, CA. Approximately 6 hours north of Los Angeles.

Check-In Registration: Check-in at the track opens 7:00 am Friday & Saturday, in the paddock building adjacent to the start/finish line. Pre-Registration will be available at the track Thursday from 5:00 – 7:00 pm.

Sound Limit: 92dbA @ 50 ft. limit is strictly enforced by the track officials, no exceptions.

Paddock Entry: There will be a one-time \$10 per person entry fee charged at paddock entrance.

Thursday, August 19: Gate opens 5:00 pm for paddock entry and pit setup. 24 hr security will be in place.

Friday, August 20: Registration opens 7:00 am. Mandatory Driver's Meeting at 8:00 am. Track goes hot at 9:00 am.

Saturday, August 21: Registration opens 7:00 am. Driver's Meeting at 8:00 am. Track goes hot at 9 am. Afternoon qualifying sprint races and track closes at 4:30 pm. Meet the Make a Wish Children and families. Special trackside Cocktail Party **sponsored by Guenter Lennarz and Vangie Fernandez.**

Sunday, August 22: Driver's Meeting 8:00 am. Track goes hot at 9:00 am. Championship Cup Races close the afternoon and the track closes at 4:30 pm.

Registration: Limited to the first 105 accepted complete & paid entries (postmark considered). Priority is given to members who have run at least one event in the last year. Run group selections are limited and not guaranteed.

Cancellation Policy: No cancellations will be accepted after August 7, 2004. There will be no exceptions.

POC Log Books: Completed Logbooks & Tech Forms required at check-in in order to complete registration.

Driver's Education Event: Friday only Driver's Education sessions will be available to POC members with a STS license and pre-approved PCA licensed members. Contact the Event Chairman for details.

Students: All students must be pre-approved. Contact the Chief Driving Instructor or Event Chairman.

Vehicle Tech Inspection: See the listing of official POC Tech Stations. Please pre-tech to avoid check-in delays. Tech inspection will be available at the track Friday and Saturday morning opening at 7:00 am.

Safety Equipment: The POC General Competition Rules (GCRs) will be strictly enforced.

Brake pads: It is *highly recommended* that you bring extra brake pads, as Laguna Seca is *very* hard on brakes. This is a problem that arises without fail every year for those who are not adequately prepared!

Trackside Services: Race fuel and tire services will be available. Call Topless Performance for your Hoosier tire needs at 602-678-1116 or 877-728-0914. All pre-orders of Hoosier tires will have no sales tax and no shipping costs. They will once again be providing mounting and balancing services at the track. Order now to be sure your tires are available and will arrive on time.

Parade Laps: Parade laps of the track will be available during lunchtime. Tickets will be \$20.00 each and may be purchased at the track with all proceeds going to the Make-A-Wish Foundation.

Lodging: The host hotel is the LAUREL INN, 801 W. Laurel Drive, Salinas, CA 93906. Call 800-354-9831 for a special POC room rate of \$74.80. This special rate is limited and only good until July 31st, so don't delay!

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

DESCRIPTION AND LOCATION OF SCHEDULED EVENT(S) _____

DATE RELEASE SIGNED _____

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or participate in any way in the EVENT(S) or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (defined as any area requiring special authorization, credentials, or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited), EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself, his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin:

1. 2.
